Patterson Baseball Complex and Washington Trust Field is a new state-of-the-art baseball stadium at Gonzaga University with a seating capacity for 1,300 fans. The complex was designed to include open club spaces, roof covered theater style seating and family friendly grass berm areas. The project involved construction of a new baseball field, relocation of the existing grandstands and a rebuild of the existing press box. The ground level pedestrian plaza connects fans to the seating areas, concessions and restroom facilities.

The project also included the construction of a clubhouse, lockers rooms, a laundry facility, training and equipment facilities ticketing office and picnic area. The complex sits adjacent to the School of Law and the McCarthy Athletic Center. The design for the complex pulled elements from both structures mixing precast concrete and masonry. Additional construction included a pedestrian plaza, stadium grandstands, clubhouse, concessions, toilet facilities, ticketing and picnic area.
